Dr. Jason Busse is an Associate Professor in the Departments of Anesthesia and Health, Evidence and Impact, the Associate Director of the Michael G. DeGroot Centre for Medicinal Cannabis Research, Director of the National Pain Centre, and the Research Director for the Centre of Excellence for Chronic Pain and Veterans at McMaster University. He has authored over 200 articles on acute & chronic pain, disability management, and research methodology, and was the Principle Investigator for the 2017 Canadian Guideline for Opioids and Chronic Noncancer Pain.

This talk will explore the evidence underlying the American College of Physicians' guideline for management of acute, non-back, musculoskeletal pain, as well as the evidence for use of opioids, cannabis and alternatives for chronic pain.

Chronic pain patients often present with additional factors that complicate recovery, such as receipt of wage replacement benefits, co-morbid mental illness, limited coping, and activity intolerance. The workshop portion of this event will discuss strategies for managing complex chronic pain patients.
