



## DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE

### TERMS OF REFERENCE

#### **Purpose:**

The Discipline Committee hears complaints brought before it by the Investigation Committee and then determines whether the member is guilty of professional misconduct and/or professional incompetence.

#### **Membership:**

As per *The Chiropractic Act, 1994* Section 32.

#### **Responsibilities:**

Responsibilities of the Discipline Committee are outlined in *The Chiropractic Act, 1994*, Section 33 and 34. Further reference regarding processes and regulatory requirements are found in the CAS Regulatory and Administrative Bylaws.

#### **Accountability:**

The Discipline Committee is accountable to the CAS Board of Directors, and will provide regular reports to the Board, through the Registrar, as well as identification of any urgent issues, as needed.

#### **Resources:**

Expenses and honoraria, if required, will be provided as per CAS policy. The Discipline Committee will have access to independent legal counsel and the CAS Registrar, as needed, to support the committee's work.
